1. COURSE/MODULE DESCRIPTION

2. COURSE/MODULE PREREQUISITES:

- b. If they did not attend Nilai 2 level with PMTS, the teacher will assess the child to make sure they know to read and write all the Tamil vowels, consonants, compound letters, simple words and basic Tamil communication to be a part of this group.
- c. Should know to recite songs and stories at least partially in Tamil using the content words.
- d. recite numbers in Tamil up to 100
- e. Write their full name in Tamizh

3. COURSE/MODULE OBJECTIVES

At the conclusion of this level the students will be able to:

- a. Read and write all the Tamil letters
- b. Recite the Tamil rhymes covered in this level
- c. Recite "Aathichudi" and "Thirukural" taught in this level with meaning in Tamil
- d. Recite the stories in Tamil using the content words
- e. Able to translate the given sentences at this level and write them in Tamil
- f. Able to take the TVA Basic Level Exam
